



VOLUNTEERS ARE INVITED TO BECOME CERTIFIED 'ENOUGH ABUSE' WORKSHOP PRESENTERS IN MERCER COUNTY

Are you interested in making your community safer for children?
Would you like to help reduce children's vulnerability to abuse?
Do you enjoy making presentations and leading discussions?

PEI Kids, lead agency of the Greater Mercer Coalition to Prevent Child Sexual Abuse, invites you to consider becoming a certified Enough Abuse trainer.

In this highly-respected role, you will present training workshops to parent groups, youth-serving professionals and community members and organizations teaching them how to prevent and identify child sexual abuse, respond appropriately to disclosures or suspected abuse, and understand and respond to sexual behaviors in children.

PEI Kids is currently accepting applications for volunteers interested in becoming trained Enough Abuse workshop presenters. Work as part of PEI Kids' Prevention Education team, responding to community requests for training on child safety and child-sexual-abuse prevention. Team members will be trained in four curricula:

1. Understanding & Responding to the Sexual Behaviors of Children
2. It's Not Just Jenna -- Preventing Child Sexual Abuse in Your Family & Community
3. He Said What, She Did What?! – Why do some children sexually offend?
4. Gatekeepers For Kids – Preventing sexual abuse in youth-serving organizations

Statewide training will be held on Wednesday, March 22 and Friday March 24, 9:30 AM to 4:00 PM, at the Department of Children & Families' Training Center in New Brunswick. **Trainees must attend both days of this two-day training.**

PEI Kids welcomes applicants with these qualifications:

- 21 years of age
- Possess a valid Driver's license &/or available transportation
- Have NO Criminal Record History (background check required)
- Attend mandatory training and meetings (twice a year)
- Can communicate well with others, comfortable presenting to groups
- Ability to use equipment (laptop, powerpoint, projector) for presentations
